About Peter Burns - Behind the list of transits that most of us look at, such as those from Mars out to the outer planets, is another set of transits, which are potentially even more powerful. These are the solar transits. Although the Sun is the most powerful body in the solar system, it has no dark side and directs the movements of the planets, and the light of the other bodies is but a reflection of its rays, the Sun's regular transits are not even considered by most astrologers. In this lecture Peter Burns will discuss some of the reasons why solar transits should be considered and included into our toolbox of techniques. Peter will also outline a method for interpreting solar transits. Peter's

new book: Solar Astrology, is due to be released later this year.

Peter Burns Biography

Peter Burns began reading palms in 1984 and spent seven years consulting at the Fremantle markets seeing approximately 1500 people each year. Since then he has been teaching and lecturing throughout Australia. Peter took up astrology in the late 1980's and gained his Astrology Diploma (FAA).

He was President of the Victorian Astrologers Association (VAA) 2006-2008, national Vice-president of the Federation of Australian Astrologers (FAA) for 3 years and was national editor of the quarterly Journal for the Federation of Australian Astrologers (FAA) for 16 years. Peter was a regular guest speaker on ABC radio in Perth and 3RRR in Melbourne Australia. Peter has lectured on palmistry and astrology on numerous occasions in most capital cities of Australia and did lecture tours in the USA and Canada in 2011 and 2012.

He now writes and teaches and organizes public exhibitions of astrologers, palmists, psychics and tarot card readers together with health and wellbeing practitioners, through his business: Body n Soul Expos.
